ethical dilemmas and decision making are a persistent feature of the everyday operations of animal shelters and animal protection organizations these organizations frequently face difficult decisions about how to treat the

animals in their care decisions that are made all the more difficult by limited funding material resources and human labor moreover animal protection organizations must also determine how to act within and toward the wider social and institutional environment in which non human animals are routinely exploited the first section of the ethics of animal shelters contains practical recommendations developed by ethicists in response to the ethical challenges identified by employees of the montreal society for the prevention of cruelty to animals these challenges arise across the organization s activities including its internal structure shelter operations public campaigns and advocacy work dealing with the public animal agriculture and governmental agencies and their work with feral animals the second section offers philosophical analyses of the ethical challenges unique to animal shelters issues explored include the killing of shelter animals shelter animals diets medical decision making procedures adoption policies and the role shelters might play in transforming social attitudes and norms

america is an animal friendly society approximately sixty eight percent of u s households own a pet about 85 million families most of us consider our companion animals family members we recognize that they enrich our lives in countless ways improve our physical and mental health and make us better people we value the fact that they don t care what we look like where we live what we do for a living or how much money we make their love for us is unconditional and we agonize over our decisions when the time comes to say farewell to them due to advanced age or disease but there is a dark side to our relationship with companion animals which is our collective shame we destroy millions of healthy and treatable animals in our tax funded animal shelters every year many people simply do not know about what happens at their local animal shelter using their money and in their name some who know about this tragedy believe there is no other way to function there is not rocket science is a story of no kill animal shelter advocacy in huntsville alabama which explains how a group of animal welfare advocates joined forces to speak with one voice to save the lives of healthy and treatable animals in the municipal animal shelter this advocacy helped change the shelter from one which destroyed more than half of the animals entrusted to its care to a shelter which saves the lives of all healthy and treatable animals instead any community can be a no kill community sometimes it just takes the courage to try something new and sometimes it just takes a group of people willing to band together and speak out with one voice to say enough we are better than this

there are many animals within the united states that don t have a home fortunately there are many animal shelters

across the country that can take them in and help them find loving owners this book provides a detailed look at the many ways these shelters care for our animal buddies

the performance of 15 animal shelters lack of standardized data regarding individual animal shelter performance limited the ability to review a larger number of shelters and provide more robust results various programs are in place within the united states to improve the collection and availability of individual shelter performance specifically the asilomar accords provide a strong framework for doing this and could significantly reduce euthanasia of companion animals if more shelters would adopt the practice of collecting and reporting their data in this format it is demonstrated in this research that combining performance data with financial data within the data envelopment analysis technique can be powerful in helping shelters identify how to better deliver results the addition of data from other organizations will make the results even more robust and useful for each shelter involved
